



COVID-19 Update

Your providers and staff at Beaches Dermatology are closely monitoring the rapidly evolving outbreak of coronavirus COVID-19. We are following the advice of both the CDC and Florida Department of Public Health. We want to assure you of the steps we are taking to protect you and your family when in our office.

Routine Office Visits:

- Yes, we are seeing regularly scheduled patients! However, we are only performing necessary procedures at this time. Wellness checks are considered necessary.
- Our staff is increasing the frequency of cleaning in the office and continue to follow recommended hand washing/sanitizing before and after all patient contact.
- We are screening for patients at risk of coronavirus exposure both when appointments are scheduled and at check-in. Patient with signs of illness will be asked to see their PCP and reschedule their visit with our office.
- No visitors will be allowed in our facilities unless you are:
 - accompanying a minor;
 - working as an interpreter;
 - assisting a patient with disability.

All other visitors will be asked to wait outside of the office.

Our goal is to keep all our patients and staff safe. If the spread of coronavirus in the state worsens, we will update our policies and procedures and keep you informed.

Patients with possible Coronavirus exposure:

If you develop fever with cough, shortness of breath, or gastrointestinal issues or have had contact with someone who is suspected to have COVID-19, please stay home and call our office to reschedule your appointment. We will be available for contact Monday-Friday from 8 am to 5 pm.
